

# PARACANOE



Paracanoe is the canoeing discipline for athletes with a physical impairment. Races are contested in two boat types; the kayak (K) and Va'a (V) in three different classifications, L1, L2 and L3.

At an international level, Paracanoe made its World Championship debut in 2010 and its Paralympic debut in 2016 where Australian athletes won a Gold, Silver and Bronze medal.

Men and Women: KL1, KL2, KL3, VL1, VL2 & VL3.

## Paralympic events

Men: KL1, KL2, KL3, VL2 & VL3.

Women: KL1, KL2, KL3 & VL2.
