It has been 24 months since the last national level Canoe Marathon event with the PA 2019 Canoe Marathon Championships in Perth, WA. We are so excited to finally be returning to competition again from the 22-24 April on the Gold Coast in the sunshine state of Queensland.

Canoe Marathon is a wonderful paddle discipline that can be enjoyed by all age groups. Marathon paddling involves paddling over longer distances with regular portages, with the paddler carrying the canoe or kayak. However, for this event there will be a non-portage option included for the beginner paddlers. PA and PQ encourage inclusiveness and invite all keen paddlers to come and try paddling Canoe Marathon.

This National Championships event for Canoe Marathon will be held over distances ranging from the shorter (3.7km) for the younger paddler, to the longer (29.6km) for the older and more experienced paddler.

There will also be selections for the 2022 Australian Marathon Team, and 2022 Australian Marathon Masters Team to compete overseas in Portugal later in the year,

The PA 2022 Canoe Marathon Championships would not be possible without the support of the Event Host PQ, the Canoe Marathon Technical Committee, the local organising committee, and the volunteers whom without we would not be able to run such a great competition.

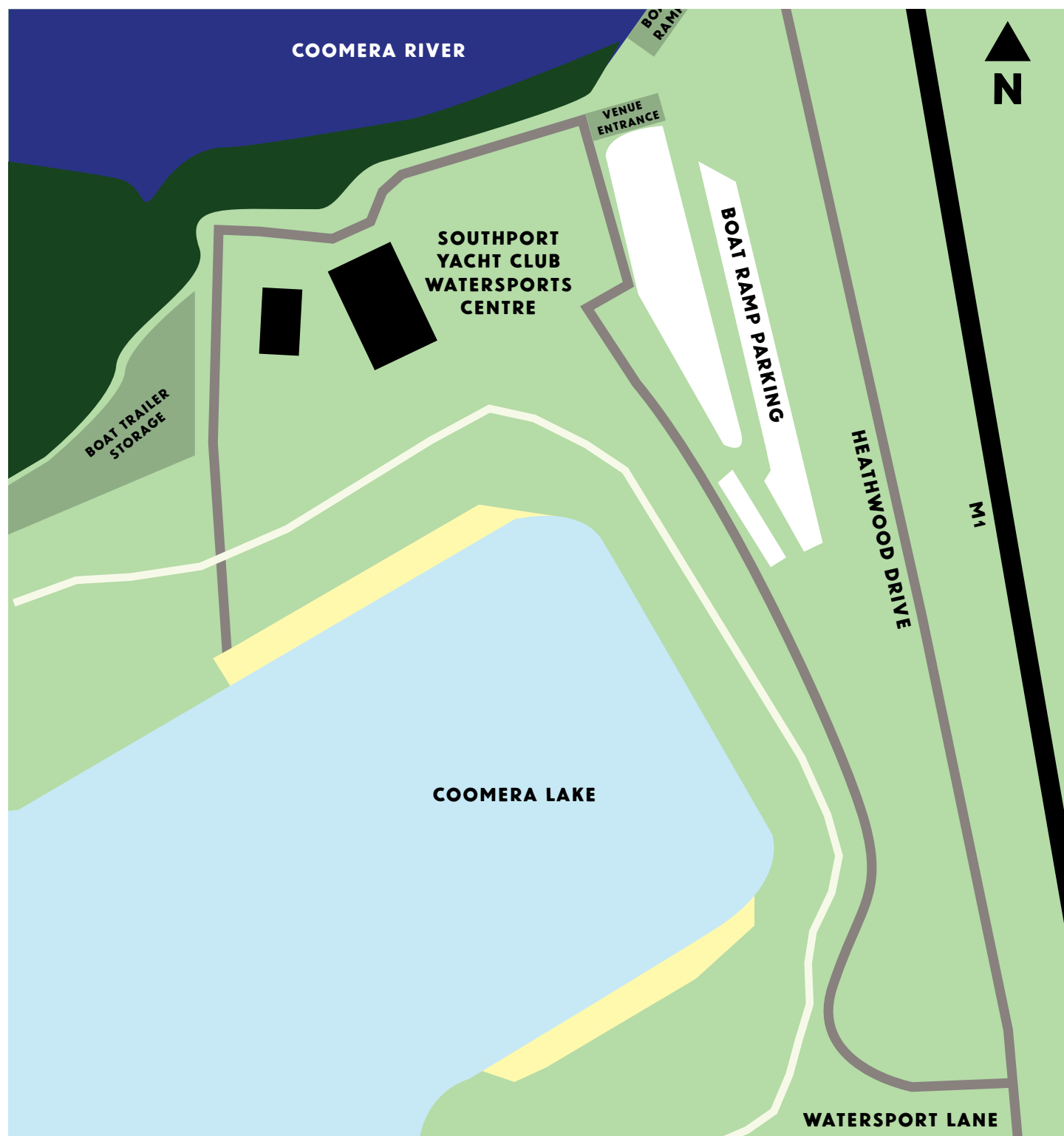

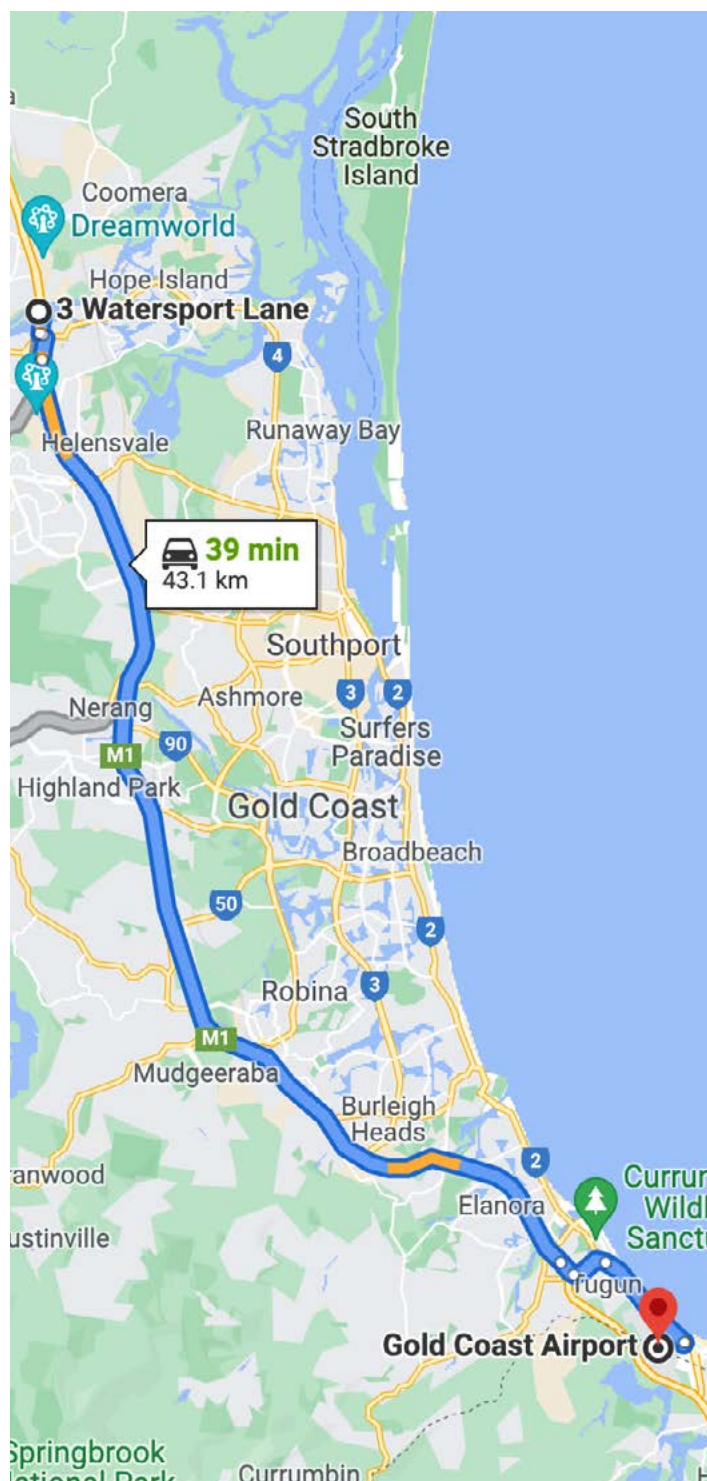
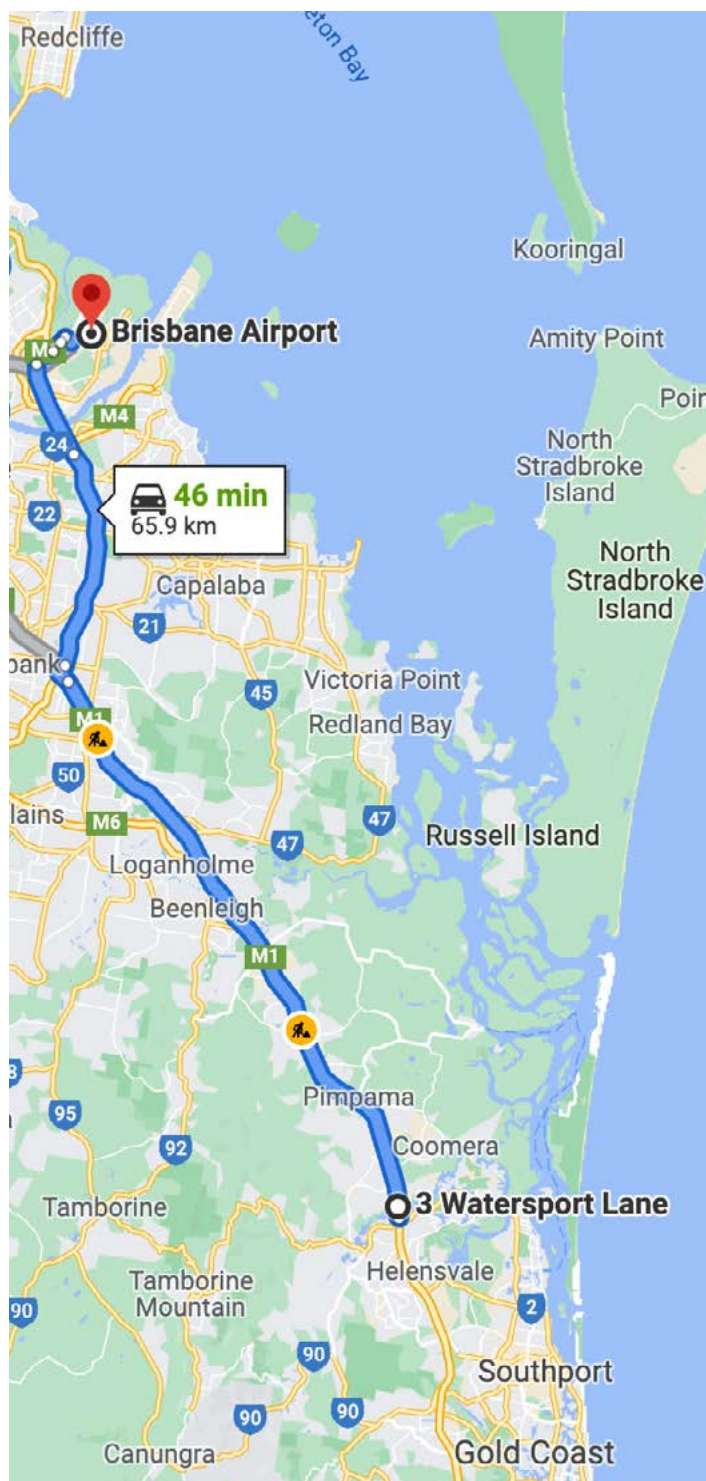


GETTING THERE

Note: This is applied when competition is conducted in classes ie not divisional.

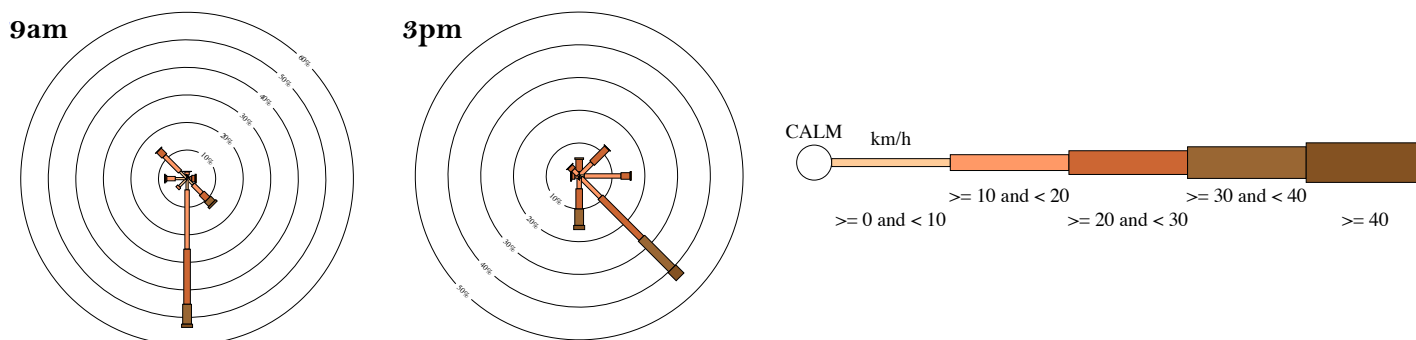
- Where there are not sufficient entries or starters to contest a certain event, competitors can be moved into a relevant event.

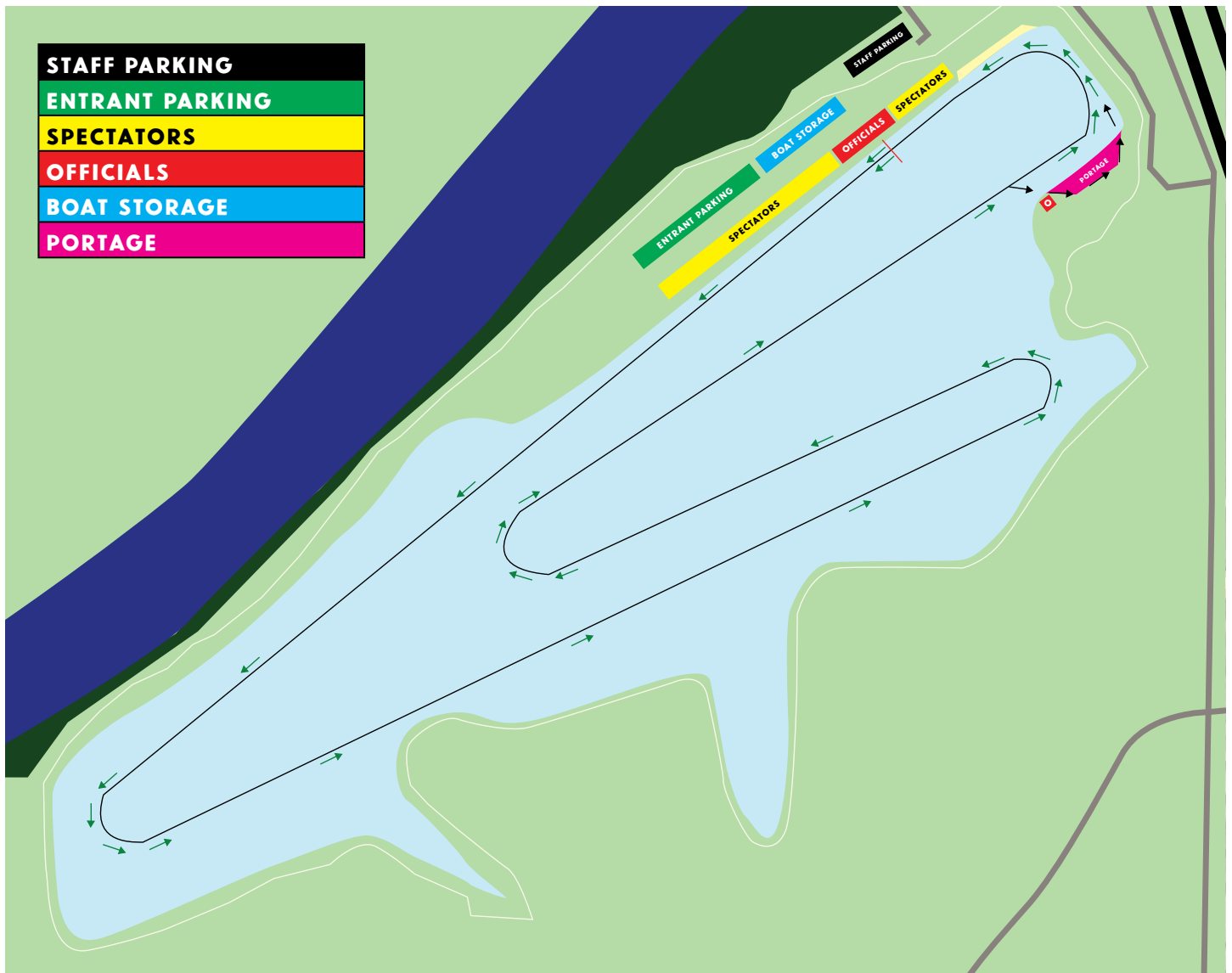

The portage has a beach entrance and exit and an grass track, approximately 100 metres in length. Coomera Lake is non-tidal with minimal current.

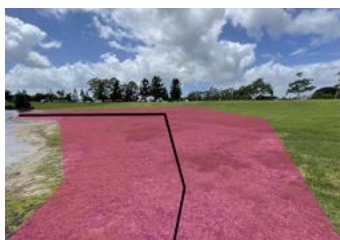


PORTAGE

Running Surface

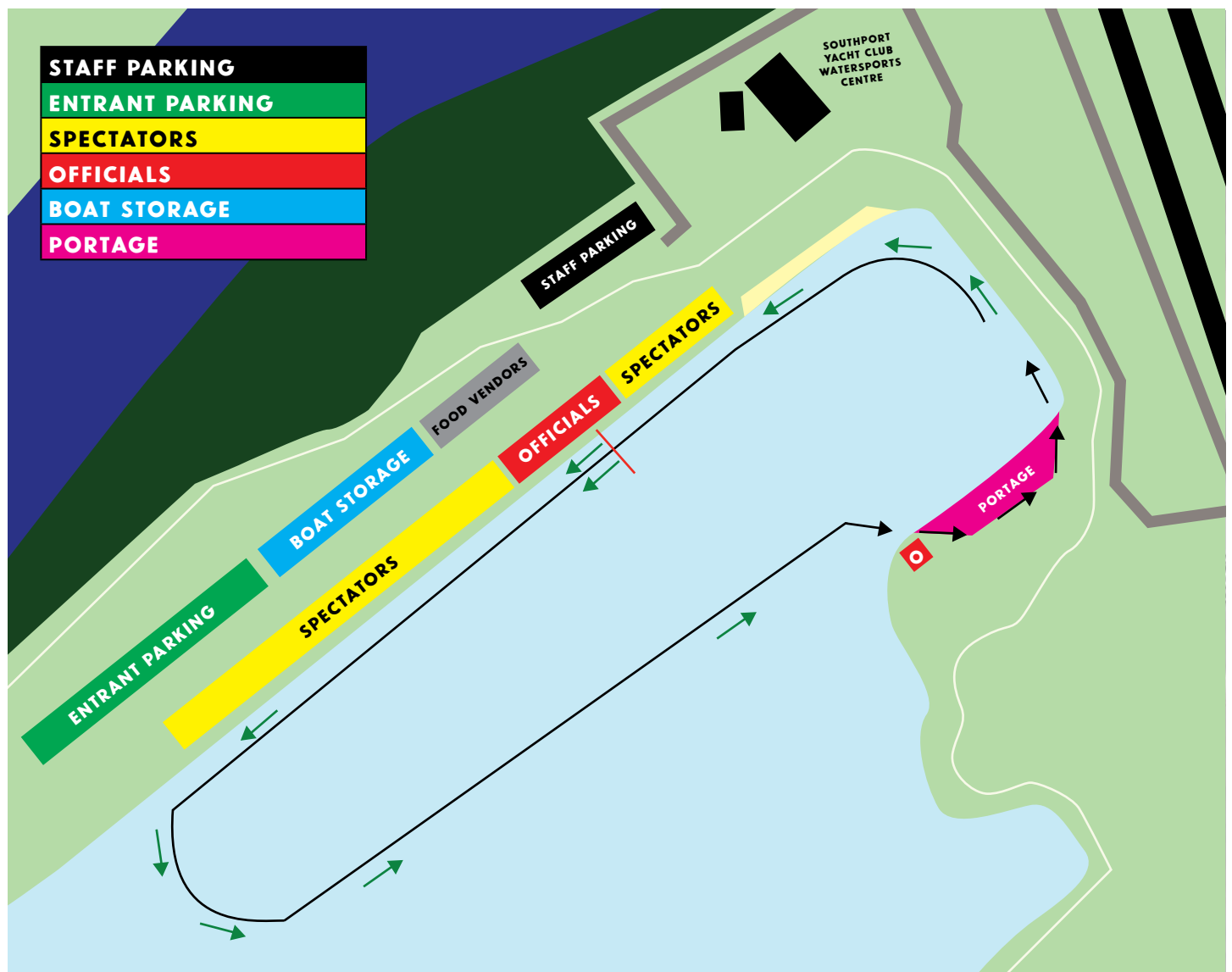


Water Entry

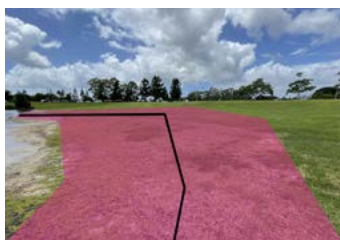

LIFE JACKETS

Correctly fitted Type 50 life jackets must be worn by:

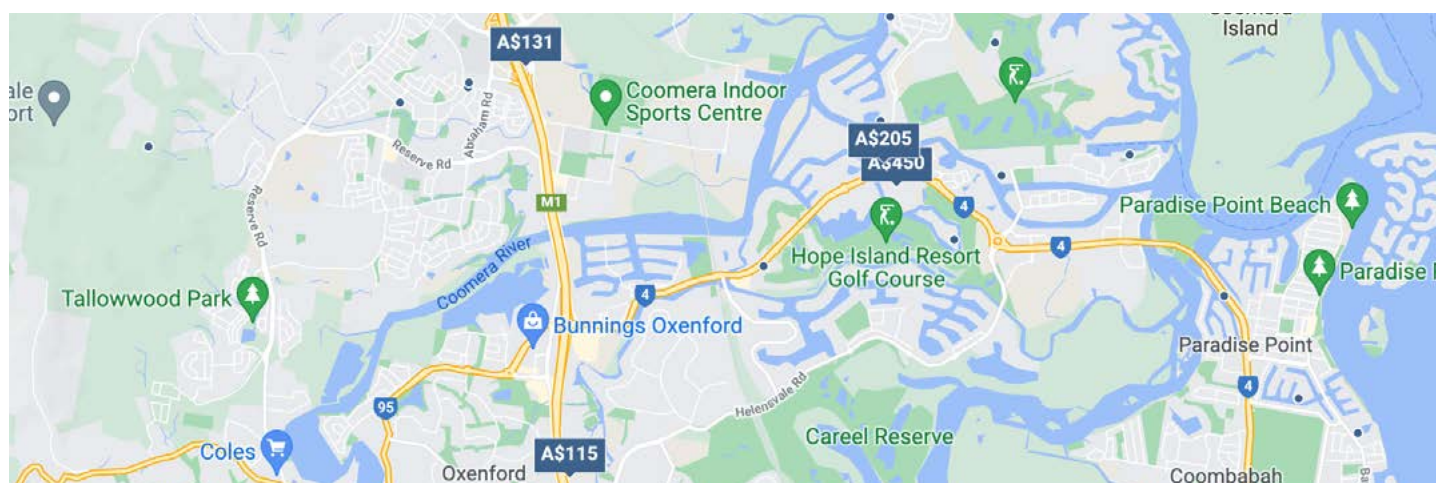
1. All paddlers competing in the Under 10, Under 12 and Under 14 categories;
2. Those who are not strong and confident swimmers;
3. All paddlers if the Competition Committee deems it necessary.

Please note, inflatable life jackets are not acceptable due to the need for the paddler to be conscious to activate the life jacket and for the need for annual testing to ensure compliance.
